FAST FACTS ABOUT VOTING IN THE NOVEMBER 6TH ELECTION

ARE YOU READY TO VOTE? Do you know where your voting poll is?

Answer: Go to Chicago Board of Elections Website and search "Your Vote Information".

Have you moved? Do you know someone who has moved?

You can change your voter info online. Deadline is October 21, 2018. https://chicagoelections.com/en/register-to-vote-change-of-address

What are the qualifications to register to vote?

Be a United States Citizen; Be born before November 6, 2000; Live in your precinct at least 30 days before the election; Not claim another location as your voting place; Not be in prison serving time for a conviction (Exconvicts are eligible to vote in Illinois but must register to vote.

When is early voting?

You can vote in person at the Loop Super Site from 9/27 to 11/5 Location: TBD (usually close to the Daley Center Underground)
You can vote at the 50 Chicago Ward's sites from 10/22 through 11/5

WHAT ABOUT VOTING BY MAIL - I can't get out to vote?

You can fill out the form online under "vote by mail" Chicago Elections.com
Telephone number: 312-269-7900 for help getting a ballot by mail.
Do you want to register to vote by Mail? The ballot MUST be at the Board of Elections before November 1, 2018.

Are there sample ballots available?

No not yet. Looks like mid to late September. GET A SAMPLE BALLOT, FILL IT OUT AND BRING IT WITH YOU TO USE. Can I really do that - YES! I fill out a ballot in advance. It saves a lot of time.

FAST FACTS ABOUT VOTING (Cont. from page 1)

Can I register to vote AND VOTE at the same time.

Only at certain locations. You MUST go to the City of Chicago board of Elections website to read the rules and know that you MUST bring 2 forms of ID. Don't wait. Register now. It takes 5 minutes!

What do I need to bring with me to Vote?

Always have your Illinois ID or Driver's License. Whether they can ask for it is irrelevant. Bring it anyway. Why take a chance. You can bring notes into the booth or sample ballots. Know who you want to vote for.

What about ALL OF THOSE JUDGES – how do I decide?


I suggest 2 things (that I do).

Go to the Chicago Bar Association Judicial Evaluations and the Illinois State Bar Association Judicial Evaluations. There you will find the list of rated judges by local attorneys appearing before the judges. I always cross compare BOTH lists (because I'm a bit nuts) to determine who has the following:

- 1. Good temperament (i.e. not a raging alcoholic crazy).
- 2. Preparation (actually reads the pleadings before/him her before the hearing).
