Every 1st and 3rd Wednesday of the month, an auction is held. Items can be viewed that same day just prior to the event. New merchandise comes to the store 2-3 times a week.

Boy, this place is smoking! Whole Leaf Tobacco is a newer business that opened around May 2012. It is located at 4945 N. Milwaukee, very close to our local Nadig Newspaper office.

Customers can buy regular tobacco (U.S. grown) and have their cigarettes rolled in a machine. A typical carton may cost \$20. But for those who don't want nicotine, there are many fruit and herb tobaccos which are used in hookah pipes or the smaller pipes called 'bubblers.' The hookah pipe is a very ornate, stand-up inhaling unit which can serve up to four smokers at a time. The choices for these flavored tobaccos are so many-but just a few of the fruity ones are grape, blueberry, margarita, rose, and melon. In the herb family, they have wild lettuce, purple spearmint, and passion flower.

The price of the hookah pipes can vary from \$10 to \$80. A can of tobacco is around \$15. Other items sold are lighters, cigarette cases, ashtrays, candles, and incense. Stewart, the manager, was very knowledgeable and helpful, especially to a person who is not a smoker and can't inhale (me). For more info, please call 773-934-1239.
