The Missions Committee of the Congregational Church of Jefferson Park

At the October 24th General meeting, we were fortunate to have Kathi DeArmas of the Missions Committee from the Congregational Church of Jefferson Park (CCJP is the JPNA host site for meetings). Kathi explained to us the outreach performed by the Church within the Jefferson Park and surrounding neighborhoods.

Kathi described the current programs CCJP supports, such as the Night Ministry, which serves the homeless on the north side of Chicago, particularly youth and young adults. Every month, the church makes 100 sack lunches for their distribution. Other nonprofit programs supported include the CARA program (training formerly homeless and at-risk adults for employment), St. Johns Mission Church, UCAN (Ulrich's Children's home, providing residences and education for orphans and wards of the state with disciplinary problems,)

CCJP also supports Lydia Home (another home for orphans and wards of the state) both financially and by collecting hats, mittens and scarves for a "warming tree" at Christmastime.

She also discussed new avenues of outreach through Chicago Cares, an online organization which provides a vast variety of volunteer opportunities for the metropolitan Chicago area.

The presentation continued into a discussion of how the church might be able to collaborate with the JPNA to better serve our community and where our members see a need that CCJP might be able to fill.

Some of the ideas included reaching out to our ward office to identify opportunities such as neighborhood cleanup, and partnering with LOCAL programs to maximize our collective effectiveness to enhance the community. These were some great suggestions. If you have any others that could be considered by this valuable community asset, please forward them through the JPNA website or bring them to our next meeting at the CCJP.
